In accordance with s.1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act (2000), I can confirm that the Human Tissue Authority (HTA) does not hold the information specified within your request.

The HTA is an independent regulator created to regulate the removal, storage and use of human tissue for research, medical treatment, post-mortem examination, education and training, and display in public.
