Response

Independent Assessors (IA) are trained and accredited by the Human Tissue Authority (HTA), but are not directly employed by the HTA.

There is variation in practice across the UK in relation to the payment of IAs. For example, many IAs are volunteers who do not receive any payment. Some IAs are not paid but can claim reasonable and agreed travel expenses, however, not all choose to do so.

We are aware that some IAs receive payment from the transplant unit with which they are affiliated; in Wales and Northern Ireland, this is £150 per assessment. We do not currently hold information about how much payments are elsewhere in the UK.

The HTA is not funded to provide any payment to IAs to undertake the role, and therefore no payment is made by the HTA.
