
These Directions remain in force:

Until the Directions are revoked

1. These Directions are given in relation to licences issued to Anatomy sector establishments under Sections 16(2)(a), 16(2)(c), 16(2)(d) and 16(2)(e) of the Human Tissue Act 2004.
2. The Directions require licensed Anatomy establishments to submit information about licensable activities being undertaken.
3. Submissions must be made to the HTA no later than **18 October 2019**.

5. The information required by these Directions will be used to:
 - a. Ensure each establishment's continued suitability to be licensed
 - b. Inform the scheduling of site-visit inspections
 - c. Inform the HTA's regulatory approach to each sector
